GAME INFORMATION **TOURNAMENT RULES**

GAMES

1. Games officiated under NJ HS rules – 20 second count to midline and 10 second count to box.
2. Games run (2) 21 minute halves running time. 3 minute half-time and one time out per team in the second half.
NO TIME-OUTS UNDER 3 MINUTES.
3. Sunday Championship Games – 35 minutes running time game (1) time out per team.
4. Tie games – at the end of regulation, games that are tied go right to sudden death beginning with a face off.
5. Man-up on time served penalties.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

1. Red Division plays 4 league games and 2 cross league games.
White and Blue Divisions play 3 league games and 3 cross league games.
2. Championship game is between the winners of their respective leagues. Only league games count for record.
3. Ties are decided by following (1) win-loss record in league.
4. (2) head to head in league.
5. (3) total goals scored in tournament.
6. (4) coin toss!

COACHES AND PLAYERS RULES

1. Teams and players must be on time for all games.
2. Proper conduct is required on and off the field at all times with an emphasis on sportsmanship and respect towards others.
3. All players staying in the dorms must treat the dorms and campus areas with respect.
4. All players must be in their dorm rooms with the lights out by 11:00 PM.
5. Any use of drugs or alcohol will result in the notification of the proper authorities and immediate dismissal.
6. Any physical abuse, hazing, or disrespect towards others will result in the notification of the proper authorities and immediate dismissal.

Coaches are responsible for their teams in between games and in the evenings (including the dorms).

Directions to Dining Hall - Busch

Dining Hall Rules

Camper Discipline Policy

Coaches and Counselors must review the following discipline policy carefully following the guidelines we have established.

1. No running or horseplay in dormitories. First offense – stop and reprimand; second offense – bring camper to On-Site Director to handle; third offense – camper will be sent home.
2. Disobedience problem on field-follow procedure listed in #1.
3. Camper found smoking, drinking, or using drugs must be brought to the Director immediately. They will be sent home on first offense – NO EXCEPTIONS!!!
4. Fighting will not be tolerated in camp. Campers found fighting should be brought to the Director and will be sent home.
5. Should a camper have something stolen, that camper and anyone accused of stealing must be brought to the On-Site Director immediately. The On-Site Director will deal with the facts and make recommendations to the Director. If a camper is found guilty beyond a reasonable doubt he will be sent home.
6. Any camper found damaging property should be brought to the On-Site Director immediately. A damage report must be filed with the University and the camper will be responsible to pay damages.
7. Any camper who hazes or abuses another camper will be sent home immediately.
